**AISSSE & AISSCE RESULTS – ISD SCRIPTS YET ANOTHER SUCCESS STORY**

It is with immense pleasure we announce that our school produced its best results in the CBSE AISSC Examination (Class XII) for the year 2013-14 by breaking all previous records. The school produced 100% results with no compartments at all.

Gokul Balakrishnan topped the Science Stream with 96.40 %, while A.Pradiksha and Lanka Sai Teja shared the second position with 95% and Abhishek J. Menon came third with 94.60%.

In the Commerce stream Prestline Jose secured the first position with 95.6%, followed by Roshan Roy Mathew with 95 % while Priya Sebastian grabbed the third position with 92.2 %. Besides, out of 50 students who appeared in the science stream 8 students scored 90 % and above, 36 students secured 70% and above and 49 students got 60 % and above. Where as in the Commerce stream out of 53 students who appeared, 6 students scored 90 % and above and 34 students secured 70 % and above. The English Department produced yet another overwhelming result of 87.3% school average, bettering past achievements, with 80% of the students securing 80% and above and 93.2% students scoring 70% and above. The school averages in other subjects are: Marketing – 84.4 %; Business Studies – 79.2 %; Computer Science – 78.4 %; Chemistry- 77 %; Physics- 73.3%; Biology – 73 %; Multi Media – 72.7 %; Mathematics – 71.7%; Economics – 67.4 % and Accountancy – 64.5 %.

The subject toppers are as follows: English- Abhishek J. Menon–97%, Mathematics- Gokul Balakrishnan, Lanka Sai Teja and Prestline Jose – 98%, Physics- Gokul Balakrishnan and A Pradhiksha – 96%, Chemistry- Sanjay Varkey George – 97%, Biology- Amulya Baiju – 89%, Computer Science- Gokul Balakrishnan -98%, Accountancy- AshishThampi–97%, Economics- Roshan Roy Mathew – 96%, Business Studies- Prestline Jose –99%, Marketing- Candice Maria Pereria–97% and Multi Media- Ashish Thampi with 89% marks.

**CBSE CLASS X EXAM RESULTS**

It is indeed a matter of great exultation for the school as class X students brought in brilliant results in the CBSE Class X Assessment held in March 2014 making all the students eligible for higher studies. Out of 185 students who appeared for the Summative Assessment, 34 of them scored a perfect 10 CGPA and 49 students got CGPA 9 and above.
