

CIRCULAR (CLASS KG I to XII)

Dear Parent,

The school is committed to ensure the safety of our students as one of our topmost concerns and priority and hence we wish to sensitise our children and parents towards the same.

Listed below are some suggested procedures to be used as guidelines for discussion with children regarding "Safety with Strangers."


- Do not accept candy or gifts from strangers. Do not accept rides with strangers or people you do not know very well.
- Do not walk alone to and from school. Walk with a friend or in a group.
- Go directly home after school. Never go anywhere without telling your parents first.
- Be cautious when approached by strangers. If a stranger stops to ask a question, WALK AWAY. NEVER go over to a stranger or a strange car, for ANY reason.
- Seek assistance if a stranger forces attention upon you. If someone is following you, run to a house where you think someone is at home and pound on the door and yell. You can also run inside a building, such as a store, where there are people. Tell parents or a teacher immediately about any suspicious person.
- Parents to ensure that your child in primary class is dropped by your transporter in front of the primary wing gate especially on rain affected days. We have observed that many children were left on the other side of the wadi on rainy days by the private transport operators / private cars which is a safety concern for the child.

With regard to the Safe Transport:

- Students must be on time at designated bus stops, the buses cannot wait for students who report late at the stop. Students who are late should not attempt to run after the bus. Instead, they should immediately inform their parents that they have missed the bus and parents are responsible to take necessary steps to reach their ward to school in time.
- While bus is in motion students shall remain seated wearing the seat belt without fail during the entire length of the journey. Moving around in the bus while it is in motion is strictly prohibited.
- Students should remain in the campus till the bus driver/assistant come and accompany them to the bus after dispersal of the school. Students are to wait until the bus has come to a complete stop before attempting to enter or leave the bus. Do not push other students.
- Students shall be courteous. Use of vulgar language on the bus will be reported to the school authorities who will then take appropriate action.
- Students shall keep the bus clean. Eating, drinking on the bus is prohibited.
- Students are prohibited from throwing items out of the bus windows. This may cause serious problems with other vehicle users on the road.
- Fighting or pushing will not be tolerated. Any such act will be reported to the school authorities who will then take appropriate action.
- Parents are advised NOT to call the driver while he is on duty. It may distract his attention from driving.
