**POST-RESULT CBSE ANNUAL COUNSELLING
STARTS FROM 28th MAY TO 11th JUNE 2017**

The Post-Result CBSE counselling will begin from 28th May and continue till 11th June daily from 8 am to 10 pm on all days. For the 20th consecutive year CBSE will be providing counselling services to students and parents to overcome common psychological problems and general queries related to Class X and XII results.

The CBSE counselling is an outreach programme which is carefully designed keeping the heterogeneity of student's population and geographical spread. CBSE Tele counselling is largely offered by trained counsellors and Principals from within CBSE affiliated schools located in India and outside India. It is a **voluntary and free of cost** service provided by the participants.

CBSE Tele-Helpline- 2nd Phase

During the 2nd Phase, **65** expert volunteers including Principals, trained counsellors, and special educators from CBSE affiliated government and private schools and psychologists will be available for Tele-Counselling.

Out of these, **47** are from India including **2** special educators, while **18** experts are located in Nepal, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (Al-Khobar, Jeddah), Sultanate of Oman, UAE (Dubai, Sharjah, Ras Al-Khaimah), Kuwait, Singapore and Qatar. The details are as mentioned hereunder:
