On the eve of Holi, people make huge Holika bonfires and sing and dance around it. On the day of Holi, people gather in open areas and apply dry and wet colors of multiple hues to each other, with some carrying water guns and colored water filled balloons.</p> <p>Onam
Onam is among the important festivals of India, wherein people wear traditional wear, adorn houses with Pookalam (floral designs), and prepare Onasadya (elaborate meal of 11/13 dishes). Events such as Vallamkali (snake boat race), Kakkotukali (clap dance), Kathakali dance, and Pulikali procession (artists dressed and painted like tigers and hunters) are held.</p> |
