NASA Trip: Our School organized a 10 day Educational Astrotour to NASA in the US from 9 June 2017 to 19 June 2017. The contingent visited the Kennedy space complex where they got an opportunity to see the Assembly Building, the Launch Pads, the Space Shuttles, the Saturn V Center, the Atlantis Museum, the Rocket Garden, had lunch and group photo shoot with the Astronaut and got the Space Shuttle Launch Experience.

The Group also visited the Lincoln Memorial, Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial, the National World War II Memorial & the 9/11 National Memorial at the World Trade Center along with a host of other recreational and amusement sites like Universal Studios, Disneyland, Madame Tussauds, Florida Mall & City Tour of Miami, went on an exciting adventure tour to Niagara Falls, took a guided tour of the Financial District of Manhattan, the Wall Street, the New York Stock Exchange, the Museum of American Finance, Ground Zero, Wall Street, the Empire State Building, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Macy's Herald Square, the Chrysler Building, United Nations, the NY Public and the Statue of Liberty on the Liberty Island.
