**NASA Trip:** Our School organized a 10 day Educational Astrotour to NASA in the US from 9 June 2017 to 19 June 2017. The contingent visited the Kennedy space complex where they got an opportunity to see the Assembly Building, the Launch Pads, the Space Shuttles, the Saturn V Center, the Atlantis Museum, the Rocket Garden, had lunch and group photo shoot with the Astronaut and got the Space Shuttle Launch Experience.
