

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The time frame of Medieval period is taken as AD 700-1750.• Old religion changed into new and new political orders were created. This age also saw the culmination of the Bhakthi movement.• Historical contexts of the Map was made in 1154 CE, the places were mentioned in Arabic language• Science of cartography was different in each period• India was known by different names at different points in history. It was only in the nineteenth century that Hindustan and India were used interchangeably by the British.• Coins, inscription, texts and architectures were the major source to study the history of this period. Manuscripts were collected by rich people, rulers, monasteries and temples. At present manuscripts are kept in libraries and archives.• Persian wheel, spinning wheel and firearms were developed.• .Rajputs became important during this period and emergence of jatis took place, They were ranked on the basis of backgrounds and occupation• Important changes in Hinduism- worship of new deities, construction of temples, growing importance of Brahmanas and the priests as dominant groups in society.
